In response to the COVID-19 pandemic affecting our community, CID will use the Dean's discretionary scholarship funds to provide an institutional non-need based scholarship for displaced workers entering the competency-based B.A.A.S Organizational Leadership program beginning Summer 2020. This scholarship will continue for the first two 7-week terms to assist prospective students affected by job loss due to the pandemic, who want to enroll in the program to obtain new skills and explore career paths in organizational leadership and related fields.

The Organizational Leadership degree is a 100% online program that has been designed specifically to prepare innovative leaders for employment in an increasingly technological and global society. This program provides opportunities for students to receive credit for what they know and can do, and allows them to accelerate completion of their degree, and because it is fully online, students are able to plan their study schedule around the rest of their day to complete the coursework. Program Highlights include:

- Flexible-paced
- \$750 flat rate per term
- Complete multiple courses for the same flat rate
- Transfer all prior coursework up to 90 hours
- Ability to reduce overall cost to completion

Minimum Criteria
