
HOUSING





ADMISSION

1 Submit Application

Visit ApplyTexas.org and choose "Texas A&M University-Commerce."

2 Request Official Transcripts

TRANSFER: Request official transcripts from all previously attended post-secondary institutions. Applicants with 12 or less transferable college/ university hours must also submit an official high school transcript. Mail or electronically submit transcripts to A&M-Commerce.

INTERNATIONAL: Submit all international transcripts to an independent credential evaluation agency for a course-by-course and semester-by-semester evaluation.

3 Send Test Scores

TRANSFER: ACT or SAT test scores are optional for admission. Submit scores using testing codes **4008** (ACT) or **6188** (SAT).

INTERNATIONAL: Submit language proficiency scores and proof of financial support.

4 Apply for Financial Aid

Submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) through FAFSA.gov beginning October 1 using code **003565** or submit the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) through CollegeForAllTexans.com.
