You must earn a grade of "C" or better in English 1301 and the selected college-level mathematics course and receive a GPA of at least 2.00 on all college-level course work to receive the Associate of Science. However, students must meet the admissions requirement for the Bachelor of Social Work program in order to be approved for this program and allowed to enroll in upper division social work classes: a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5, a minimum GPA of 2.5 in Pre-Major and Support Classes, must have a "C" or better in the three Pre-Major social work classes (SOCW 2361; SOCW 2362 AND SOCW 2389 and in PSYC 2301 and SOCI 1306, must have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours. Social Work courses that classified in the Workforce Education Course Manual (WECM) can only be used as general electives and not towards the major.
