Steps to Gaining EC-6 Teacher Certification – Educational Aide

Requirements to be Met to be Approved for Student Teaching	Check if Completed or Indicate Date to be Completed
Gain District Approval to Complete Student Teaching as Educational Aide. <i>Note:</i> Some districts do not permit aides to be compensated while completing student teaching.	
Fully admitted to the Field-Based Teacher Education Program (occurs during Eled 300)	
Hold an Educational Aide Certificate (TEA requirement) – Include Copy of Aide Certificate	
Overall GPA of 2.75	
“C” or above in ELED 300 (requires 30 hours of Observation and Observation Reflection)	
“C” or above in PSY 300	
Pre-Internship Courses GPA of 2.75	
Specialization Courses GPA of 2.75	
Basic Skills Requirements for Reading, Math and Writing	
❖ Reading (THEA, ACT or SAT only)	
❖ Math (THEA, SAT, ACT, TSI Test or “C” in College Math)	
❖ Writing (THEA, SAT, ACT, TSI Test or “C” in English 101 or 102)	
GPA of 2.75 in Supplemental Areas, i.e. Sped and Bilingual	
Grades of “C” or above in Supplemental Areas, i.e. Sped and Bilingual	
Completed with grade of “C” or above in following courses:

- Rdg 350 (requires 15 hours of observation)

Application for Substitution for Experience (if applicable)

You may be eligible to have your second semester (residency) waived. You must have two (2) full years of verifiable classroom experience in the content area / level you are pursuing certification, in order to be considered for a waiver.

The application for Substitution for Experience should be submitted at the same time the application for Internship is submitted, if possible.

Note: If your application to substitute experience for coursework is approved (waive 3sh of Eled 422), your Internship semester will be waived. You will complete only one (1) semester of student teaching, i.e. clinical teaching.

If you are not eligible for the waiver (do not have minimum of two (2) years of aide experience), or the waiver is not approved, you must complete both semesters of student teaching.

Final Requirements:

- Maintain all courses with grades of “C” or above, and maintain required GPA
- Conferred Bachelor’s Degree in the area seeking teacher certification
- Successful completion of all required TExES exams
- Apply for State Standard Teaching
- Apply for Fingerprinting, if applicable
