Parking Lot Permits

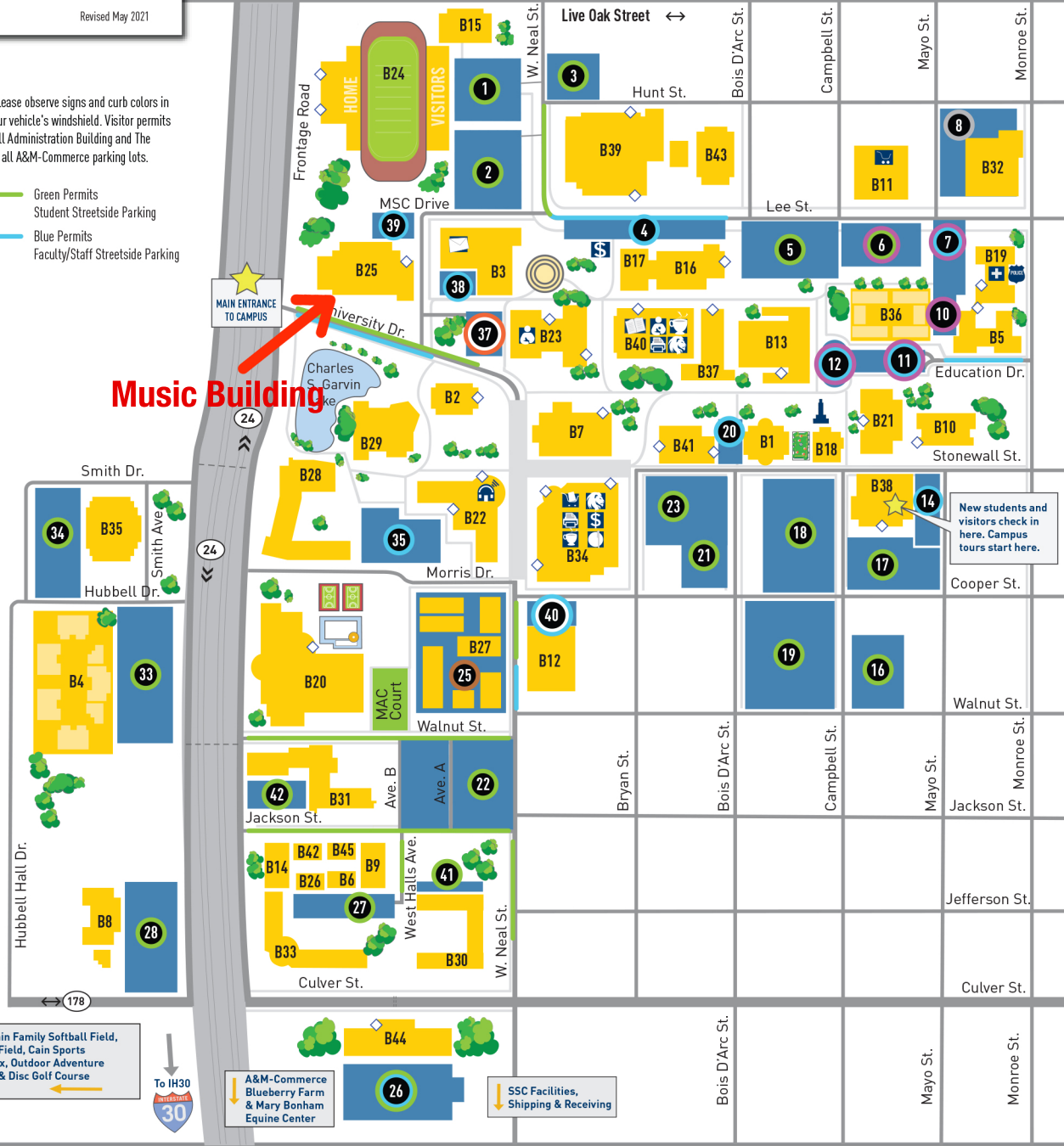

> CONCEALED CARRY POLICY <
