



## International Student Statement of Finances English Language Institute

Below is the estimated cost of study for one year at A&M-Commerce for an F-1 or J-1 international student studying in the English Language Institute. Please note this is an *estimate* of expenses for one year of study in the ELI. Students are required to provide proof of funding for one year of study in the ELI before they may receive an I-20 from A&M-Commerce.

### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR FUNDING:**

- Bank account (checking, saving, CD's):
  - Should be dated **within six (6) months** from **first day of semester admitted**.
  - Should be official and clearly identify account holder's name, type of account, bank name and branch
  - Should contain the specific amount of money available (**statements with non-liquid assets, property, credit card, bonds, stocks, retirement account are not acceptable**)
  - The ELI or the International Student Service Office reserves the right to require original financial documents
- Government funds:
  - The I-20 cannot be issued until a financial guarantee with the student's name, university name, and academic major student is admitted has been provided.
- Sponsor living in the U.S.
  - Sponsors living in the U.S. will be required to also submit the [I-134 Affidavit of Support](#) and any supporting documents required with this form. ***Sponsors will only need to include the funding information they are submitting to the university on the I-134 (not salary, tax forms, real estate, etc...).***
