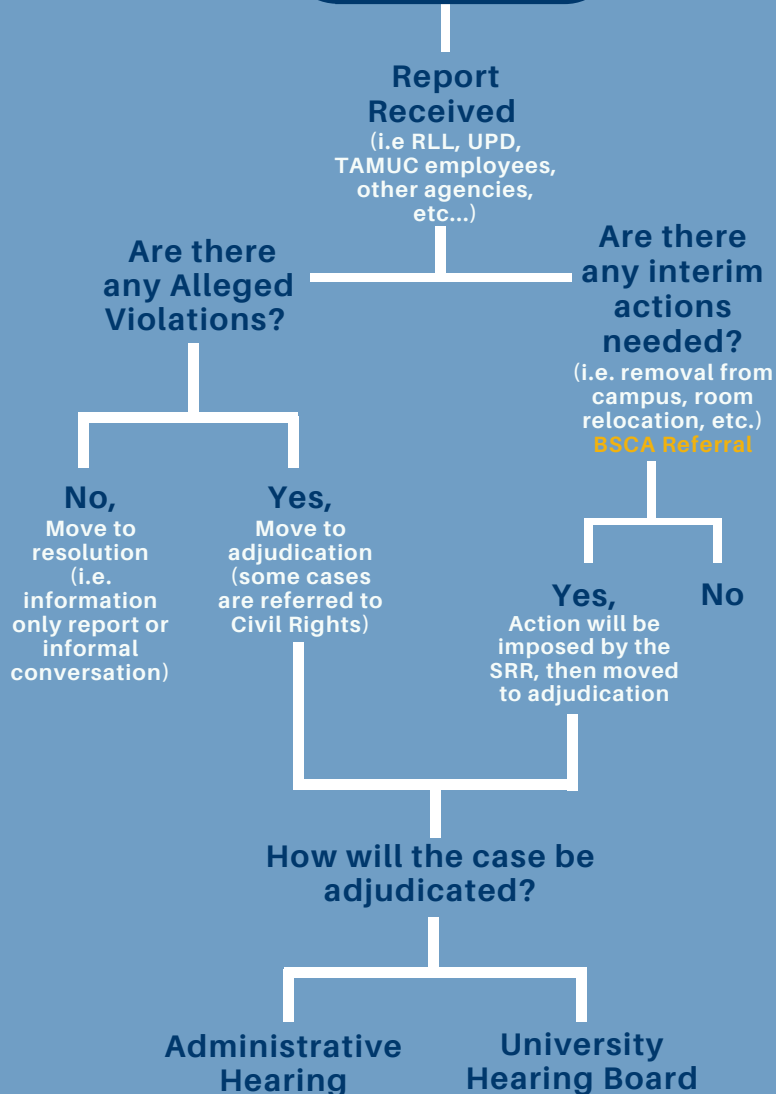


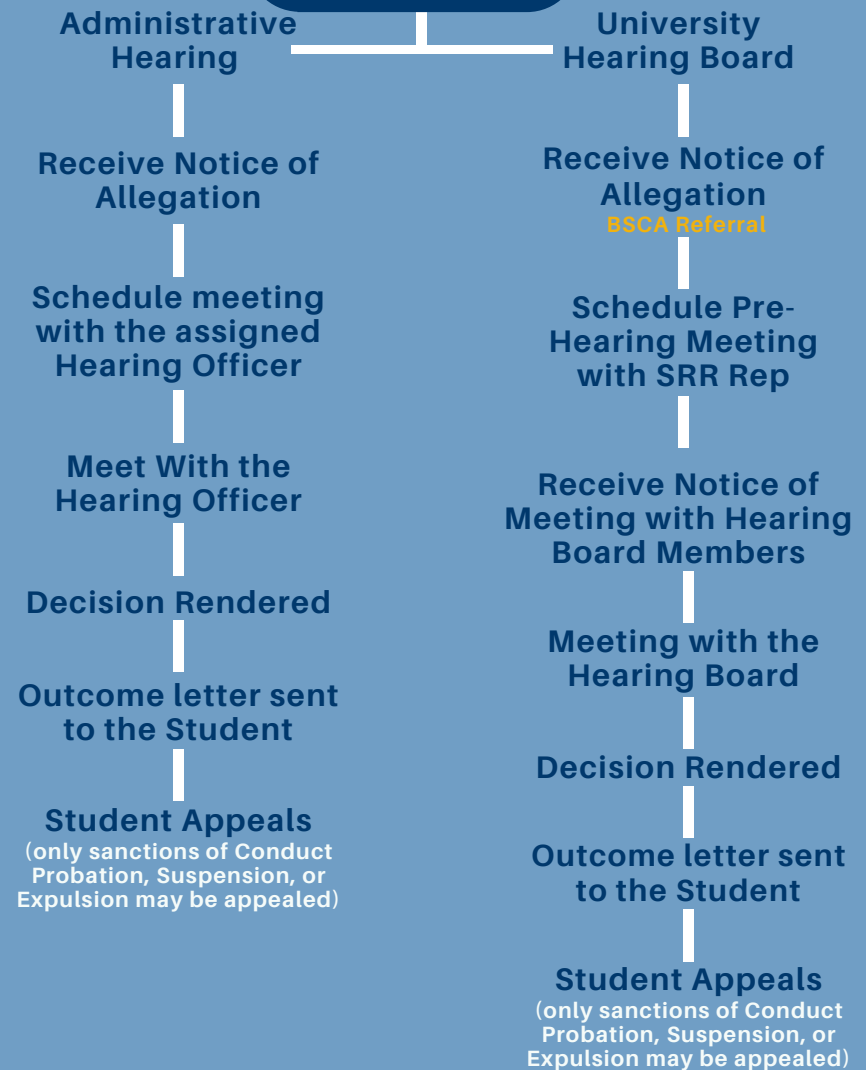


THE STUDENT CONDUCT PROCESS AT A GLANCE

THE STUDENT CONDUCT PROCESS AT A GLANCE

PHASE 3:

First Appeal

Eligible for appeal

BSCA Referral

Student submits appeal

Are there grounds for an appeal?

No, Initial findings/sanctions are upheld

Yes, Findings/sanctions are modified, upheld or remands the case

(The board may request to meet with student)

Outcome Letter sent to the Student

PHASE 4:

Second Appeal

The Student has a right to a second appeal

BSCA Referral

Yes, Grounds for appeal were not met in the first appeal or the sanction imposed is conduct probation or lower

No, The initial findings and sanctions are upheld

Student submits appeal to Dean of Students

DOS reviews appeal and case history

DOS renders a decision

Outcome Letter sent to Student
