Each applicant must first apply and meet general requirements of the Graduate School.

- 1. Applicants must hold a valid Texas teaching certificate (or) successful scores on the TExES exam (or) have a satisfactory score of the combined verbal and quantitative portions of the GRE.
- 2. Previous coursework (undergraduate or graduate) grade point average must be 2.75 overall or 2.75 on the last 60 hours in the undergraduate program.

### **DEGREE PLAN ADVISEMENT**

This advising guide is not official. DegreeWorks (DW) records your grades on classes completed and requirements yet to be completed. You and your advisor will use DW to track your progress and make advisor-approved changes in your plan.

# **MASTERS COMPREHENSIVE EXAM**

Students are required to take and pass a written comprehensive examination during the semester they graduate. Exams are given three times a year; fall, spring, and summer 1. It is important to apply during the very first week of your final semester. # **GRADUATION APPLICATION**

Because the window to apply for graduation is extremely short, it is important to apply <u>during the first</u> <u>two weeks of the semester you plan to graduate</u>. Then update your degree plan and email it to your advisor who must have it to endorse your application for graduation.
