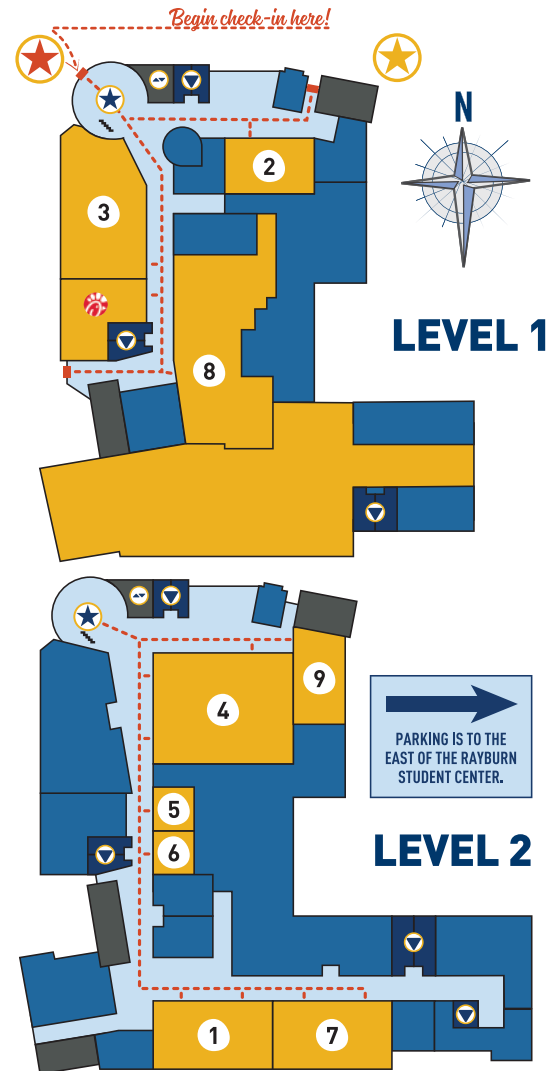


# RAYBURN STUDENT CENTER MAP



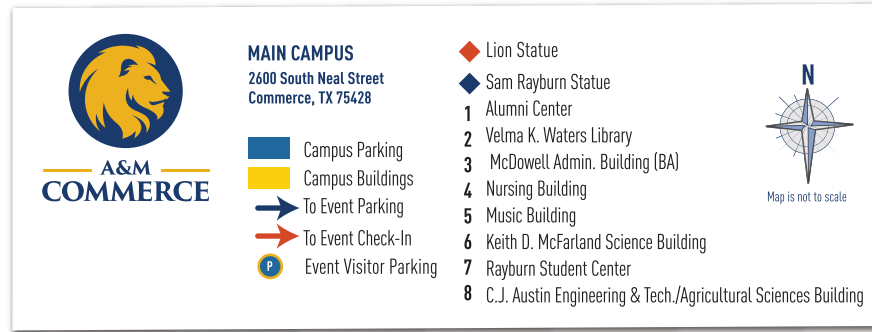

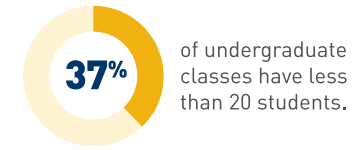

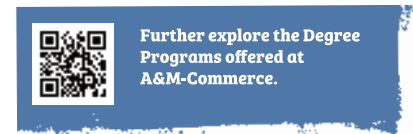
