Prerequisites:

COUN 501 (Orientation) must be completed **before** Basic Skills - minimum grade of "B" required.
COUN 510 (Theories) must be completed **before** Basic Skills – minimum grade of "B" required.
COUN 516 (Basic Skills) must be completed **before** Advanced Basic Skills – minimum grade of “B” required.
COUN 548 (Advanced Skills) must be completed successfully before Practicum (COUN 551).

The students are recommended to take following classes before practicum 512, 522, 530, 517, 540, 545, and 564.

Prior to enrolling in COUN 551, students must have finished their 10 required sessions of personal counseling as described in COUN 516.

Applications submitted before the deadline posted on the Clinical Applications web page will receive first consideration for available classes. Preference is given to students who are fully admitted into the Counseling Program.
